Dear Applicant,

To qualify for the Lead Hazard Control Program you must have a child under the age of 6 that lives at the property, or visits at least 10% of the time (approximately 3 days per month).

If you have children that regularly visit, please have the child's parent/guardian fill out the attached (on reverse side) to qualify for the program.

This child will also need to have a blood lead level test to make your property eligible for the Lead Program. The Visiting Nurses Association (VNA) can conduct these tests at no out of pocket cost to the client. Call them at 563.556.6200, to set up an appointment.

If the child has already had a blood lead level test in the last 6 months, we can accept those results, please submit them with this letter.
