1. Call to Order

The Dubuque Transit Advisory Board meeting was called to order by Daughters, Board Chair at 4:28 pm.

2. Review/approve the agenda for the Thursday, March 12, 2020 Transit Advisory Board meeting

3. Review/approve the minutes from the Thursday, November 14, 2019 Transit Advisory Board meeting

Motion by Enderson, second by Gerdemann to approve the minutes from the November Transit Advisory Board meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

4. General Public Comments & Service Requests

A question was asked about how members of the public can request a new bus stop for fixed route service. Tyler mentioned the options available to the public and what is needed to approve a new bus stop.

5. Ridership Report

Tyler reported the ridership statistics for November 2019 through February 2020.

6. Contingency Plans for COVID-19

Enderson inquired about the Jule's plans for the COVID-19 pandemic. Tyler responded that if the situation arose, fixed route service could be suspended, and full-time operators would work on paratransit. Part-time operators

would be offered backup hours. Tyler added that the Jule will monitor ridership and see about reducing service if needed.

7. Bike to Work Week

Daughters mentioned Bike to Work Week was coming up again in May and asked if the Jule would continue to offer free rides to bikers during that week as has been done in the past. Tyler stated they would plan to continue this event. Gerdemann offered to reach out to the Telegraph Herald about having an item regarding Bike to Work Week in the newspaper.
