New Business

Review and approve new Washington Neighborhood Homeowner Rehabilitation Program

Neyen introduced the proposed changes to the loan terms for the Washington Neighborhood Homeowner Rehabilitation Program. The changes would provide 0% interest for all income levels. The payments for each income level had also changed providing: <30% due on sale, <50% \$40.00 a month, and <80% \$60.00 a month.

After thorough discussion, Walsh moved to approve the proposed changes to the Washington Neighborhood Homeowner Rehabilitation Program as submitted. Hingtgen seconded. Roll call. All present in favor. Motion passed.

Information Sharing

Alvin Nash, Housing and Community Development Director informed the Commission that the Housing Department is starting a rebrand campaign for the Housing Choice Voucher Program. He explained it was still in the early planning progress, but would provide updates as the process moves forward.
