



YARD WASTE & FOOD SCRAPS

Diverting yard waste and food scraps from the landfill is easy!

Yard waste and food scraps (organic material) can be set-out in a variety of ways. Whether with a City-issued cart, brown bags with single-use stickers, or your own 35-gallon can with an annual decal or single-use sticker, we've got you covered!

Option	Fee
Annual Yard Waste Decal	\$40
64-gallon City-issued Cart	\$10/month*
Single-use yellow sticker	\$1.50
13-gallon Food Scrap Cart	\$1/month

**Customers are charged from April - November for a total of \$80 per year*

Did you know?

Yard waste and food scraps being diverted from the landfill helps reduce the production of methane gas and turns your waste into something beneficial -- compost!



LARGE ITEM PICK-UP

Curbside collection of excess trash, large/bulky items, and electronics.



The City offers collection of large items, including electronics, for a fee. Schedule a collection using the QR code below or call 563-589-4250. Collections are preferably done on your regular trash collection day. Collections on a different day cost an additional \$20.

Landfilled Material

Examples include extra trash, furniture, or other large items that do not fit into your trash cart.

- Equivalent of 10-12 kitchen trash bags (or about the size of an average couch) - \$13

Recyclable Material

- Appliances - \$20 each
- TVs and monitors - \$20 each
- Small-corded items (VCRs, keyboards, vacuums, fans, cables, chargers, speakers, etc.) - \$6 per pickup
- Automobile tires - \$6 each
- Large metal material (grills, bed rails, etc.) - \$6 per pick-up

CHOOSE YOUR CURBSIDE COLLECTION CONTAINER

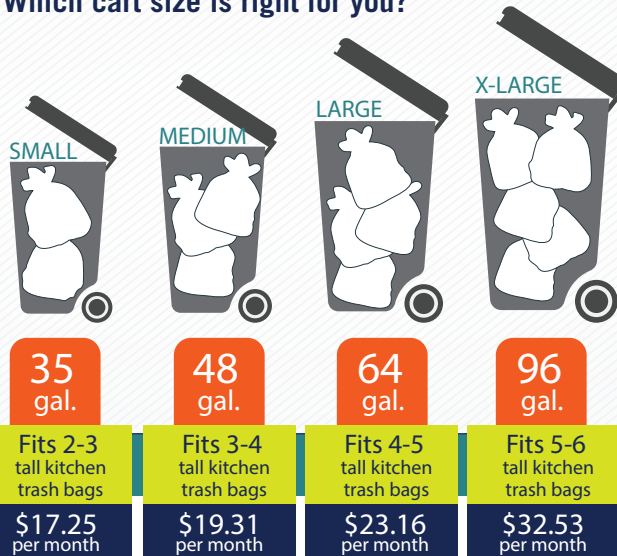
The City of Dubuque offers a volume-based fee structure for curbside trash collection.

PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Properly place your container to ensure your trash is collected.

Trash and recycling **MUST** be set out by 6 a.m. on your collection day.

Leave 2 ft. of space around cart(s).



Do not overfill cart.



Do not place cart near parked vehicles, poles, trees, etc.

Single-Use Stickers



Use single-use green stickers for excess trash or smaller items weighing less than 40 lbs. and smaller than 2' x 3' that do not fit in a cart. They are available for purchase in sheets of five (\$10) at area grocery, discount, and hardware stores, and at Utility Billing in City Hall at 50 W. 13th St.



RECYCLE MORE, WASTE LESS!

The City's **FREE** curbside recycling program is the easiest way to divert materials from the landfill. Large recycling carts are also available at no charge to the customer.

YES!

Put these items in the recycling.

- Paper/Cardboard
- Metal/Aluminum
- Plastics (#1 - #5)



NO!

These items should **NOT** be recycled and should be put in the trash.

- Plastic bags
- Wrapping/tissue paper
- Styrofoam
- Clothing
