Seven proposals were submitted in response to the HUD Resiliency Infrastructure Project Request for Proposals. The RFP Review Committee reviewed the proposals and selected four firms for interview. Following the interviews, the RFP Review Committee considered the strengths and weaknesses of the teams and ranked them. By a unanimous consensus, the committee deemed IIW to have submitted the top proposal.

City Engineer Gus Psihoyos requests City Council approval to negotiate and enter into a contract for IIW, PC to provide engineering services for the 17th Street/West Locust Street Storm Sewer Improvements Project and the 22nd Street/Kaufmann Avenue Storm Sewer Improvement Project, both associated with the Community Development Block Grant Program Disaster Recovery - National Disaster Resiliency funds for the Bee Branch Watershed Flood Mitigation Project.
