**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
FEDERAL AID AGREEMENT FOR A TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES  
PROGRAM (TAP) PROJECT**

Whereas, the City of Dubuque is proceeding with the Bee Branch Trail, Phase I.

Whereas, the trail will be located on from 16th/Sycamore intersection to 12th Street, then east approximately 600 feet toward Kerper Blvd.

Whereas, the Bee Branch Trail, Phase I project will involve the construction of a 10-foot-wide paved multi-use trail. The project is planned to be constructed in 2020 and is part of a multi-phase trail to be built along the restored Bee Branch Creek that will extend connections to two regional trails -- Dubuque Heritage Trail and Mississippi River Trail -- as well as to the citywide trail system. The project is part of a phased trail connection to the Jule public transit service and bicycle/pedestrian amenities at the City's Intermodal Transportation Center on Elm Street.

Whereas, the Iowa Department of Transportation (Iowa DOT) has authorized the use of federal funds for eligible costs for the Bee Branch Trail, Phase I.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBUQUE, IOWA:

Section 1. That the Mayor be authorized and directed to execute the Iowa DOT Transportation Federal-Aid Agreement for an Iowa's Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Project Agreement (20-TAP-117) between the City of Dubuque and the Iowa Department of Transportation be hereby approved for the Bee Branch Trail, Phase I: from 16<sup>th</sup>/Sycamore to 12<sup>th</sup> St.
