PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Dubuque will be holding a Public Hearing to review an application for a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan and to make available to the public the contents of an environmental information document and the City's project plan. These documents include design and environmental information related to the proposed improvements as part of a Pilot- Private Lead Service Line Replacement Program.

The project consists of the functional replacement of private lead water service lines within Dubuque by trenching or pull-through methods to prevent the potential for drinking water contamination at a house-by-house level. At this time, Dubuque intends on replacing approximately 585 lead service lines in three phases starting in 2024.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to inform area residents of this proposed work, discuss costs associated with this project, and to address citizens' concerns, if any, with the plan.
